Qualifications

- 🏰 Applicant must be a permanent resident of Baldwin County, Alabama
- 🏰 Must be currently enrolled as a senior at a Baldwin County public high school
- 🏰 Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 🏰 Applicant must have taken ACT or SAT test for entering college and have sufficient score to permit entry into Auburn University.
- 🏰 Applicant must be in need of financial assistance, which must be clearly indicated on application.
- 🏰 Must be accepted to Auburn University with intent to attend in fall semester.
- 🏰 Family members of BCAC Board Members are not eligible.

Applicants Must Submit

- 🏰 A copy of high school transcript that includes ACT and SAT scores
- 🏰 Two letters of recommendation – one from an educator & one character reference. The letters of recommendation should emphasize the student's contributions, achievements, need and character.
- 🏰 A copy of your letter of acceptance to Auburn University or proof of application.
- 🏰 Completed copy of application
- 🏰 Essay on “Why you have chosen to attend Auburn University” to be no longer than two typed pages.

**Personal interviews may be necessary in the final selection process.*

Additional Information

In the event there is not an eligible student at a high school, no scholarship will be awarded. If funding is not available for six individual scholarships, all applications will be combined and the quantity of scholarships will be awarded based on criteria met and available funding. The scholarship program can be terminated due to lack of funding at any given time.

Applications and details of scholarship program will be delivered to the six Baldwin County High Schools each year. Applications must be completed in entirety, postmarked and returned with letters of recommendation, transcripts and essay, to the proper address by **March 31st** of this year. The scholarship will be awarded in May of the same year. When possible the presentation of scholarships will be made by a member of the Baldwin County Auburn Club to the student on his or her high school's honors and awards day.
